Physical Therapy is a healthcare specialty concerned with treating disorders of the musculoskeletal system and its interaction with physical movement. The goal of physical therapy is to restore maximum functional independence to each individual patient before or after surgery. Stretching and strengthening exercises are used to help speed recovery. Our physical therapists work closely with patients to tailor a program that is appropriate for their diagnosis and their rate of recovery. I
